

GLAD ROBINSON YOUSE ADULT COMPOSERS CONTEST

CA 5-1

Biennial, Odd Numbered - \$600*

The Glad Robinson Youse Composers Contest is for talented composers whose works have not been published. Eligible composers must be citizens of the United States and active members of currently federated senior clubs or senior organizations (not associates), or individual senior members with \$50.00 dues paid by *October 1* prior to the contest year (send \$50.00 check payable to National Federation of Music Clubs). A \$10.00 entry fee must accompany the application which must be received by January 15 in the odd numbered years.

Previous 1st place winners of this award are not eligible to compete again. No out of date forms will be considered for judging.

Materials to be submitted for application must be sent to Connie Craig, Chairman, 4025 Edgewood, Hannibal, MO 63401 and must include:

\$10.00 entry fee payable to NFMC

\$50.00 Individual Sr. Membership dues if not already a member of NFMC

and

Composers may submit one composition (manuscript only-no recordings) in any of the following categories:

1. Piano or Electronic Keyboard Solo or Duet; 2-10 minutes
2. Wind or String Solo with or without an accompaniment; 2-10 minutes
3. Chamber Music; 4-10 minutes
4. Vocal Solo; 2-4 minutes
5. SSA or SATB Choral; 2-6 minutes

Electronic instrumental compositions not accepted except for electronic keyboard.

Winner will be asked to submit their social security number to the NFMC treasurer (IRS requirement)

*In the event of financial shortfalls, advertised award amounts may be adjusted. Applicants would be notified of the award change.
