Telling about the song, its origin and composer, is enlightening to all attending.

Each club should purchase a supply of Together We Sing books from NFMC Headquarters. These books include various American songs and folk songs as well as a few hymns, so we can broaden our knowledge of different types of American songs and learn about the composers and authors of these songs. Many of the songs in the books are copyrighted and may not be copied unless permission is secured from the copyright owner. The Together We Sing list will be found in the PFMC Roster and Directory and also in the PFMC President's Manual.

Each club is encouraged to appoint a Together We Sing Chairman, purchase Together We Sing books from NFMC Headquarters, and use the books to sing the song of the month at each monthly program. Club members can also use the books at area hospitals, nursing homes, retirement homes, senior centers, and for other programs throughout the community.
